
Correction: *Incidence of laboratory-confirmed influenza disease among infants under 6 months of age: a systematic review*

In figure 2 and online supplementary table 3, Bennet (2016) are reported to have found an influenza incidence of 144 per 10000 in infants younger than six months; however, the correct figure is a median yearly incidence 1998–2014 of 144 per 10^5 in this age group, which equals 14.4 per 10000. This correct figure is among the lowest in similar settings, and considerably reduces the variability of reported incidences. The corrected figure 2 is shown below:
