Importance	Ability
100	 + <b>Problem Sensitivity</b> — The ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem, only recognizing there is a problem.
94	 + <b>Oral Expression</b> — The ability to communicate information and ideas in speaking so others will understand.
91	 + <b>Oral Comprehension</b> — The ability to listen to and understand information and ideas presented through spoken words and sentences.
81	 + <b>Inductive Reasoning</b> — The ability to combine pieces of information to form general rules or conclusions (includes finding a relationship among seemingly unrelated events).
81	 + <b>Written Comprehension</b> — The ability to read and understand information and ideas presented in writing.
78	 + <b>Deductive Reasoning</b> — The ability to apply general rules to specific problems to produce answers that make sense.
75	 + <b>Written Expression</b> — The ability to communicate information and ideas in writing so others will understand.
72	 + <b>Speech Clarity</b> — The ability to speak clearly so others can understand you.
