Since 2017, the price of a doctor's consultation has increased to SGD 13.50 per consult, and the price of lab tests payable by patients has similarly inflated by about 10 percent. Most doctors will pair a repeat potassium with creatinine, unless creatinine was normal or stable to begin with for patients with existing chronic kidney disease.
