Trial oversight and management

The ERIC consortium consists of 6 partners:

- (1) Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin: represented by the principal investigator (CS), clinical lead and consortium lead. Department of Anesthesiology and Operative Intensive Care Medicine is the coordinating centre of the ERIC project;
- (2) Department of Health Care Management, Technical University Berlin: healthcare economists;
- (3) Fraunhofer FOKUS, Berlin: IT and telemedical specialists;
- (4) Ernst von Bergmann Klinikum Bad Belzig gGmbH, Bad Belzig: weaning- and ventilation centre specialized for post-ICU aftercare and post-intensive care syndrome (PICS);
- (5) BARMER, Wuppertal: The major health insurer involved is one of the largest statutory health insurance providers in Germany with 8.4 million policy holders. The ERIC project was planned and initiated by inclusion of BARMER patients only;
