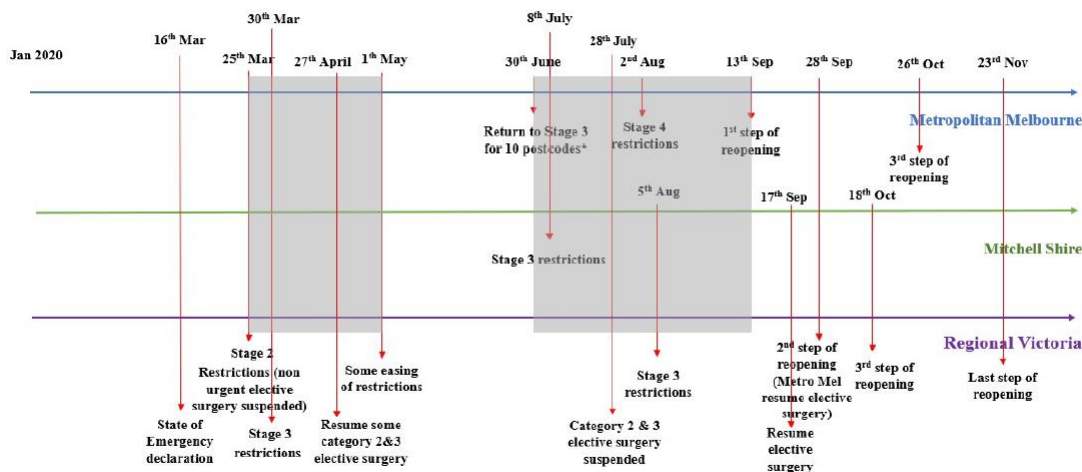


APPENDIX 1: COVID19 restrictions in Victoria, Australia (timeline)

APPENDIX 2: Tier 2 data collection (customised data fields specific to CoMaND as they appear in the Birthing Outcomes System™)

NB. Personal identifying fields such as UR, Infant Date of birth, and Mother date of birth will be removed by the local sites prior to submission to study database (grey cells). These fields are required to conduct the data extraction but are then converted to month and week level data (for infant birth date), and maternal age at delivery (for maternal DOB) before removal. Hospitals that do not use the Birthing Outcomes System (RWH) will extract equivalent data wherever possible.
