Do you recall being approached by your GP to participate in a study for stroke prevention?

How were you approached to participate in the study?

Was the study explained in detail to you?

Did you understand the study/ what was it explained to you?

How did you find the screening procedure?

Did the GP/nurse use an electronic hand-held device? A blood pressure monitor? Ask you about smoking status?

Do you recall the GP/nurse doing anything else during the consultation about your risk of stroke?

Were you happy with the overall screening procedure?

If so/not, why?

Have you had any change in your medical treatment, and/or any additional tests, and/or been referred to a specialist following the consultation on your stroke risk?

Do you think the programme is a good idea?

Would you recommend it?

If so/not, why?
