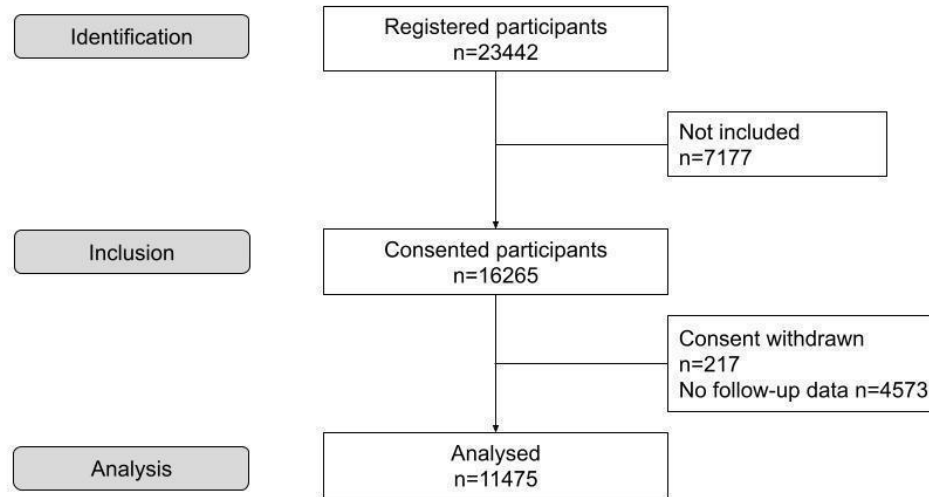

**Figure S2: Follow up records reporting a perceived improvement in health and wellbeing**

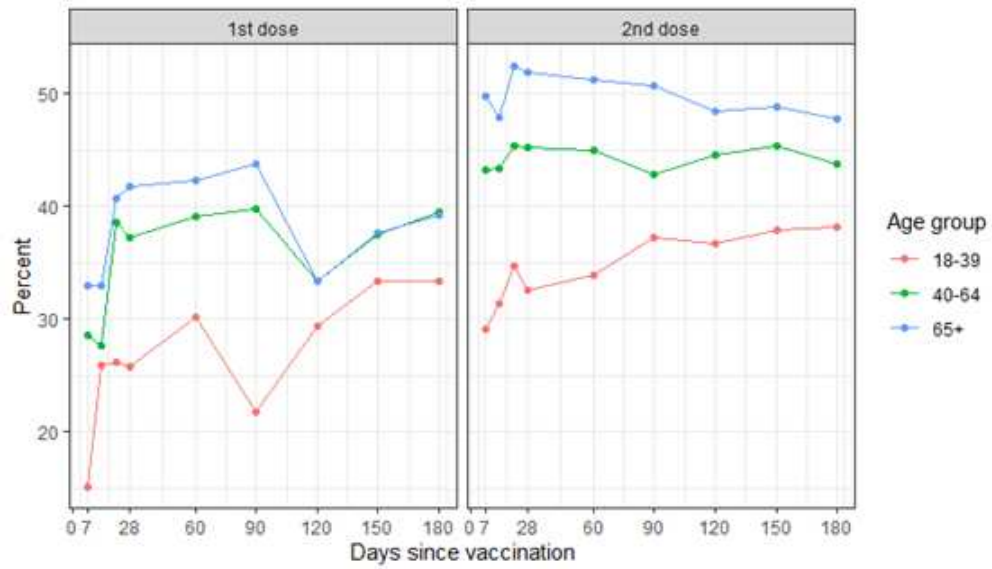


Figure S3: Kaplan-Meier curves for menstrual symptoms in women aged <65
