

## FGD GUIDE FOR PORCHIC GROUP FGD ON NON-RECEIPT AND UNTIMELY RECEIPT OF ROUTINE CHILDHOOD IMMUNIZATION

Q1. Why do some children not receive routine childhood immunization or vaccinations?

**Prompts:**

1. Why do some mothers not take their children to receive routine childhood vaccinations?
2. Why do some children not received all the routine childhood vaccinations (they receive some and do not receive some, they do not complete all the vaccinations)?

**Probe:**

1. The proximal supply-side (PHC facility and PHC worker related) determinants or barriers
2. The proximal demand-side (community/village and household/parents related) barriers

Q2. How can these problems be solved? That is: The problems of some mothers not taking their children to receive routine childhood vaccinations and some children not receiving all the routine childhood vaccinations

**Prompts:**

1. Based on your own experience, what can be done by the households or parents?
2. What can be done by the community or village?
3. What can be done by the health facility or PHC workers?
4. What can be done by the government?

**Probe:**

1. Feasible short-term solutions to the proximal supply-side (PHC facility and PHC worker related) barriers
2. Feasible short-term solutions to the proximal demand-side (community/village and household/parents related) barriers

Q3. Why do some children not receive routine childhood vaccinations the time or age they are supposed to receive them?

**Prompts:**

1. Why do some mothers delay before taking their children to receive routine childhood vaccinations?
2. After a child receives vaccination at health facility, the health worker always gives the mother/caregiver appointment for next vaccination.

Why do some mothers miss the appointment and the children do not receive the vaccinations on exactly that appointment date (maybe received them on a later date)?

**Probe:**

1. The proximal supply-side (PHC facility and PHC worker related) barriers
2. The proximal demand-side (community/village and household/parents related) barriers

Q4. How can these problems be solved? That is: The problems of some mothers delaying before taking their children to receive routine childhood vaccinations and some mothers missing the appointment dates for their children vaccinations.

**Prompts:**

1. Based on your own experience, what can be done by the households or parents?
2. What can be done by the community or village?
3. What can be done by the health facility or PHC workers?
4. What can be done by the government?

**Probe:**

1. Feasible short-term solutions to the proximal supply-side (PHC facility and PHC worker related) barriers
2. Feasible short-term solutions to the proximal demand-side (community/village and household/parents related) barriers

Q5. Is there any other thing you want to say about why some children do not receive all routine childhood vaccinations and why some children do not receive the vaccinations the time or age they are supposed to receive them?
