## Barriers for willing recipients

- Passivity 1
- Disempowerment <sup>1</sup>
- Lack of social support <sup>1</sup>
- Not willing or able to ask

### Perceived barriers to willing donors

- Financial concerns<sup>2</sup>
- Location of donor <sup>2</sup>
- Duration of work-up

#### **Knowledge and Information**

- Transplant knowledge basic
- Lack of information on living kidney donation
