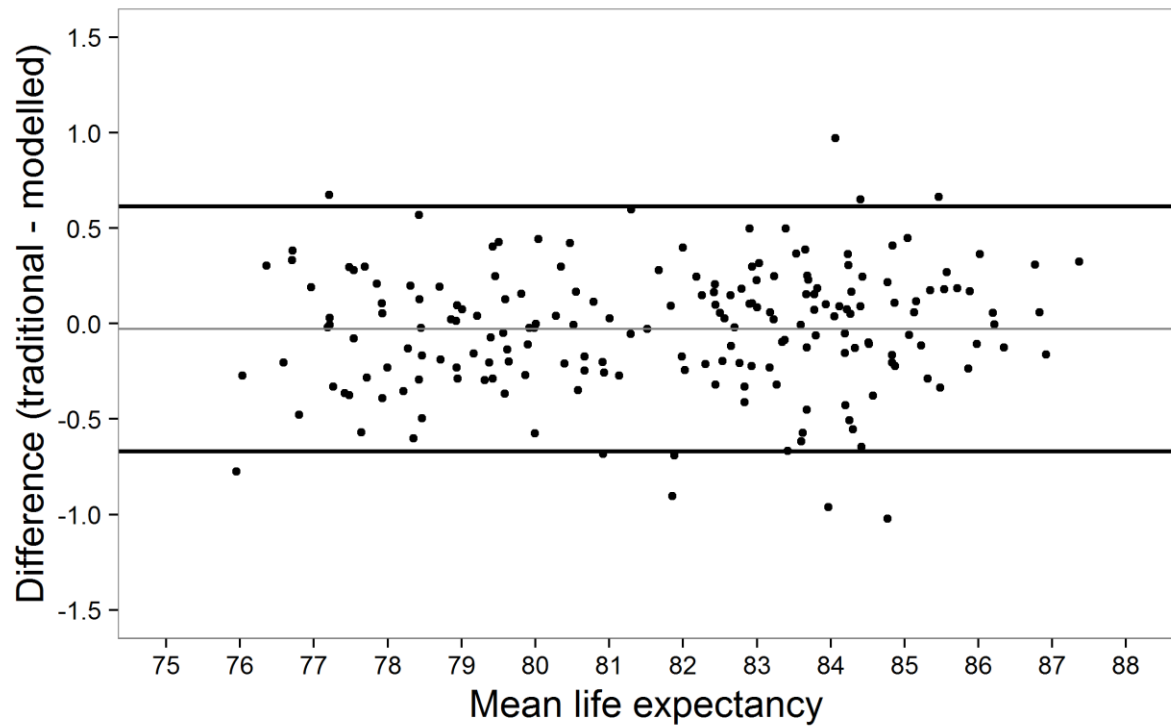


Supplementary Figure 1 Agreement between traditional and modelled life expectancy estimates. Differences are represented by filled circles, the thin grey line represents the marginal mean difference between estimates, and the thick black lines represent the upper and lower limits of agreement.



Supplementary Figure 2 Heat map matrices of differences in life expectancy between socioeconomic status (SES)-remoteness strata for males and females, and between genders, for 2001 (A) and 2012 (B). Differences are represented by red shading for females (upper half), blue shading for males (lower half), and purple shading between genders (diagonal cells). Lighter shades represent smaller absolute differences. Differences are computed as row-column for females, column-row for males, and females-males for between genders. MC: Major city; RR: Regional/remote areas; 1-5 represent SES quintile.
