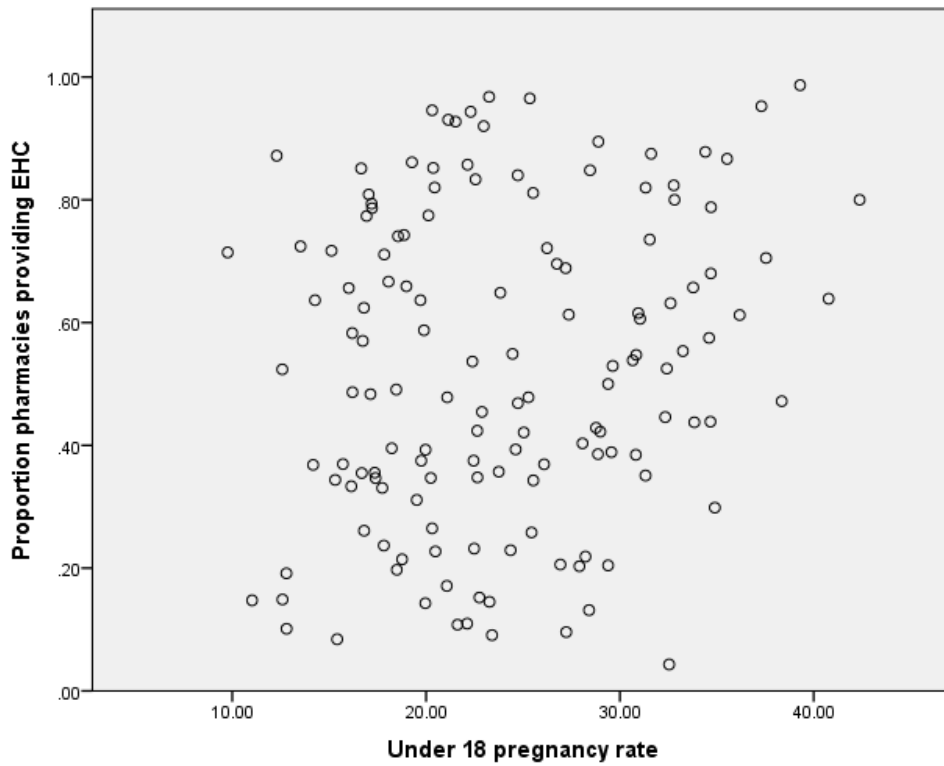
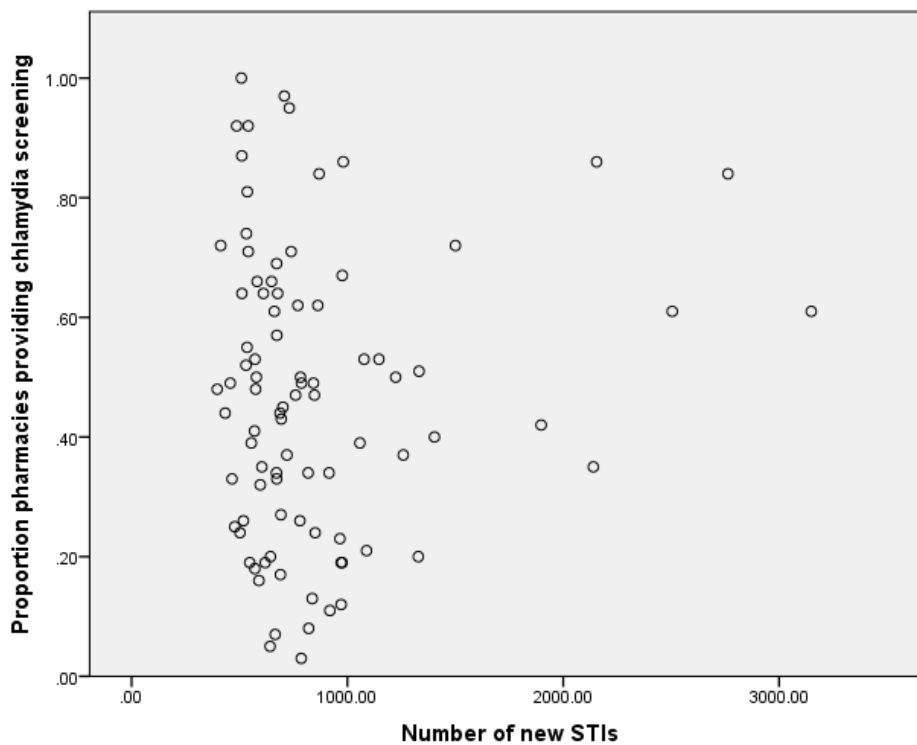

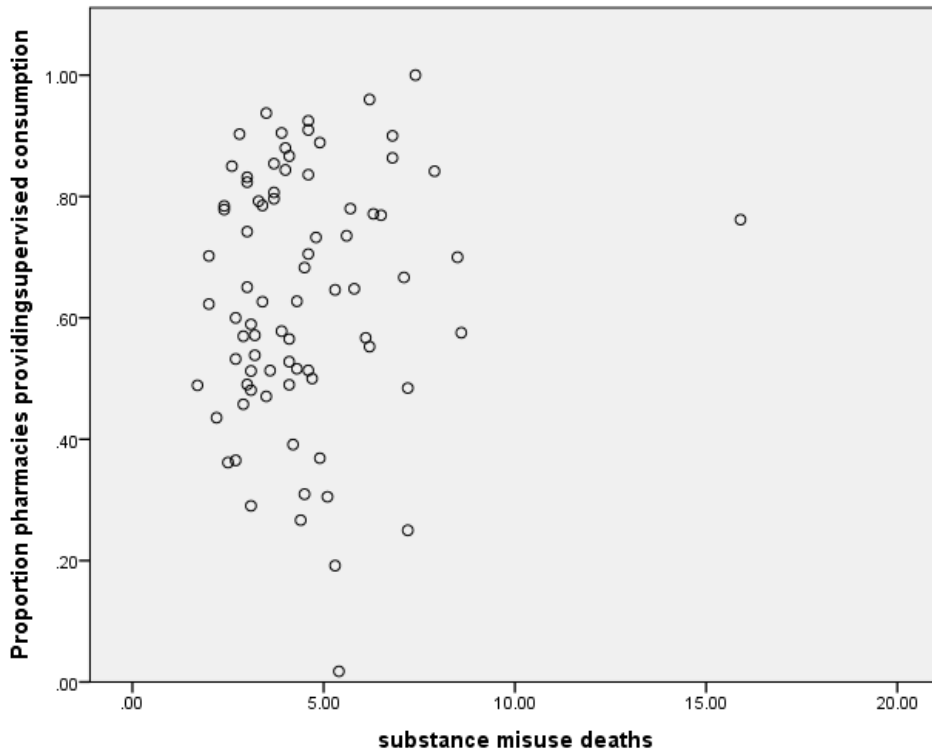

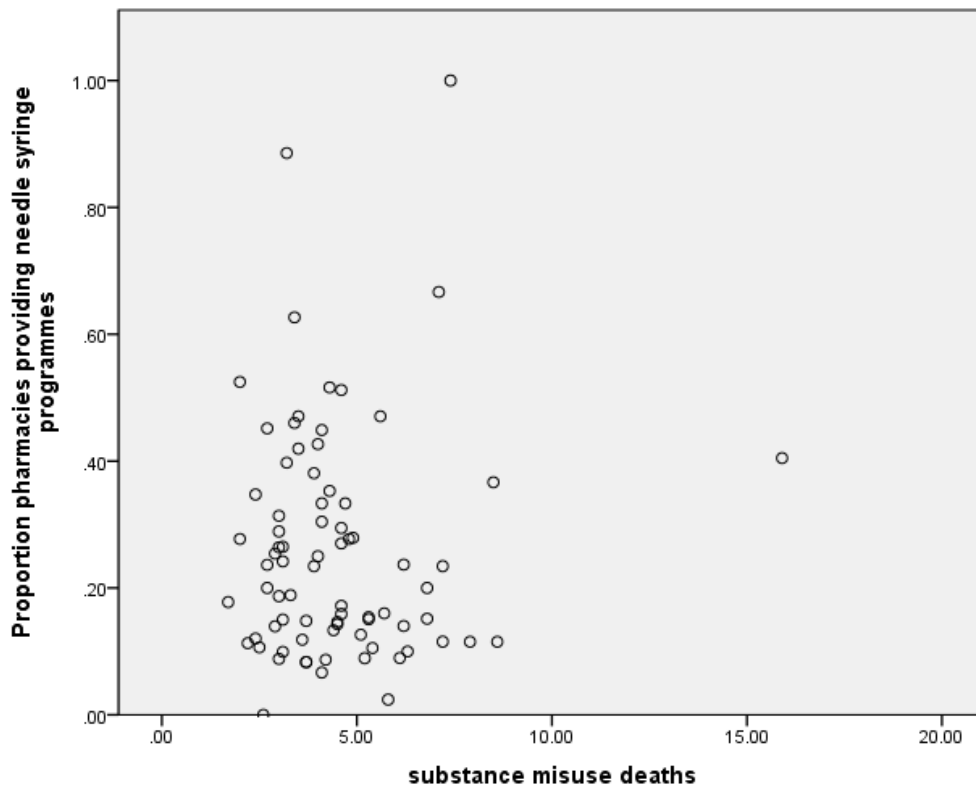
Chlamydia screening – proportion pharmacies providing against new STIs per 100,000 population (n=88; r=-0.078; p=0.467)



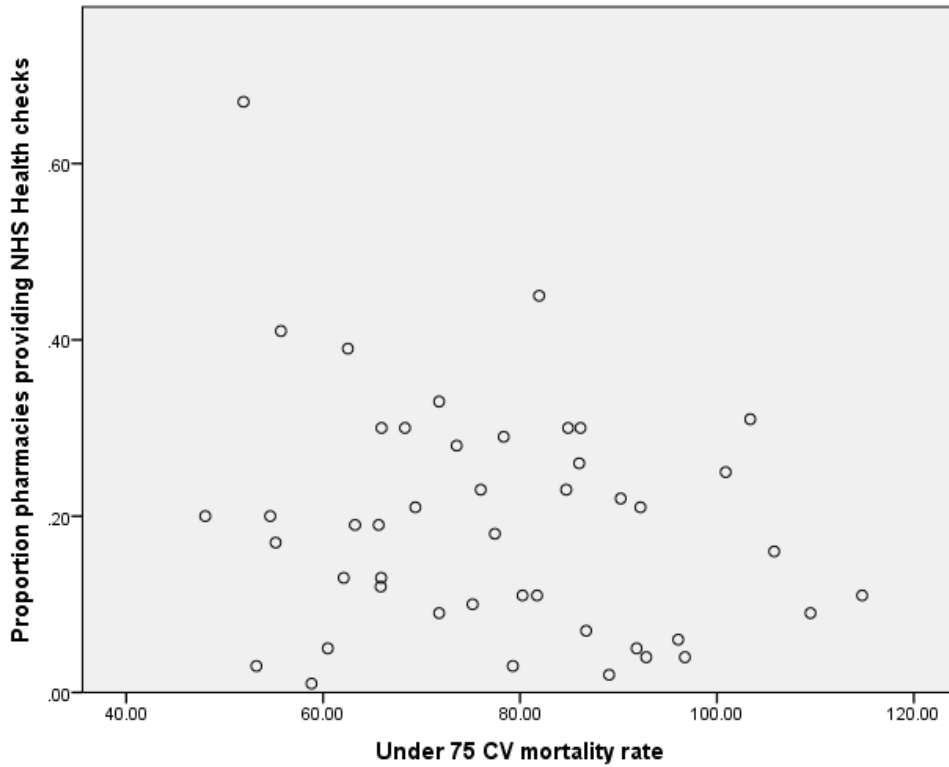

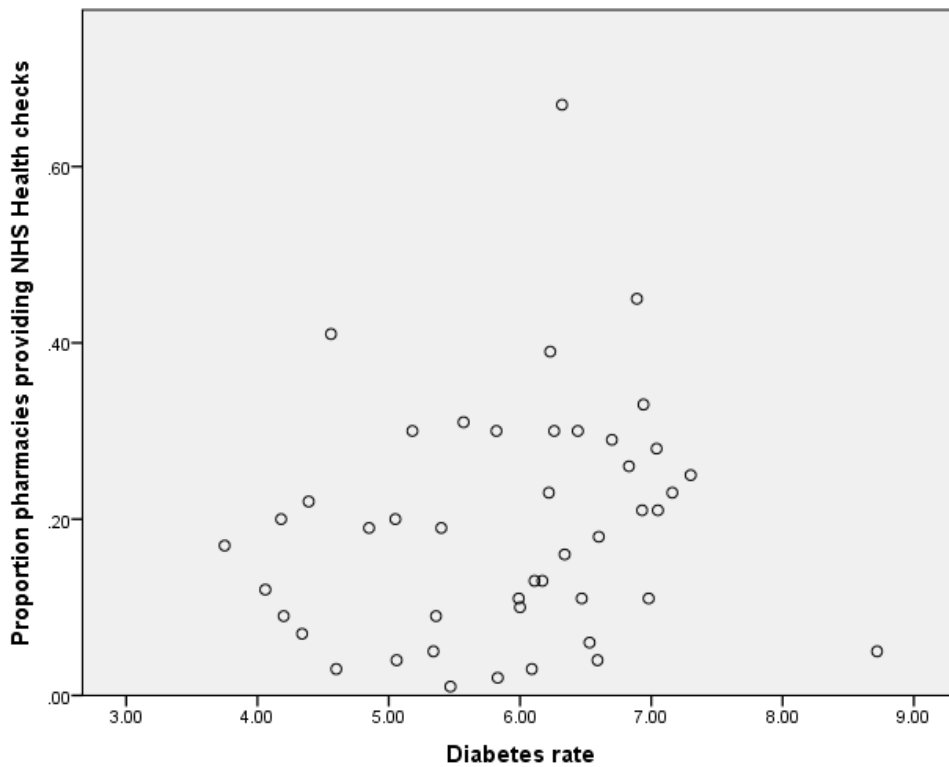

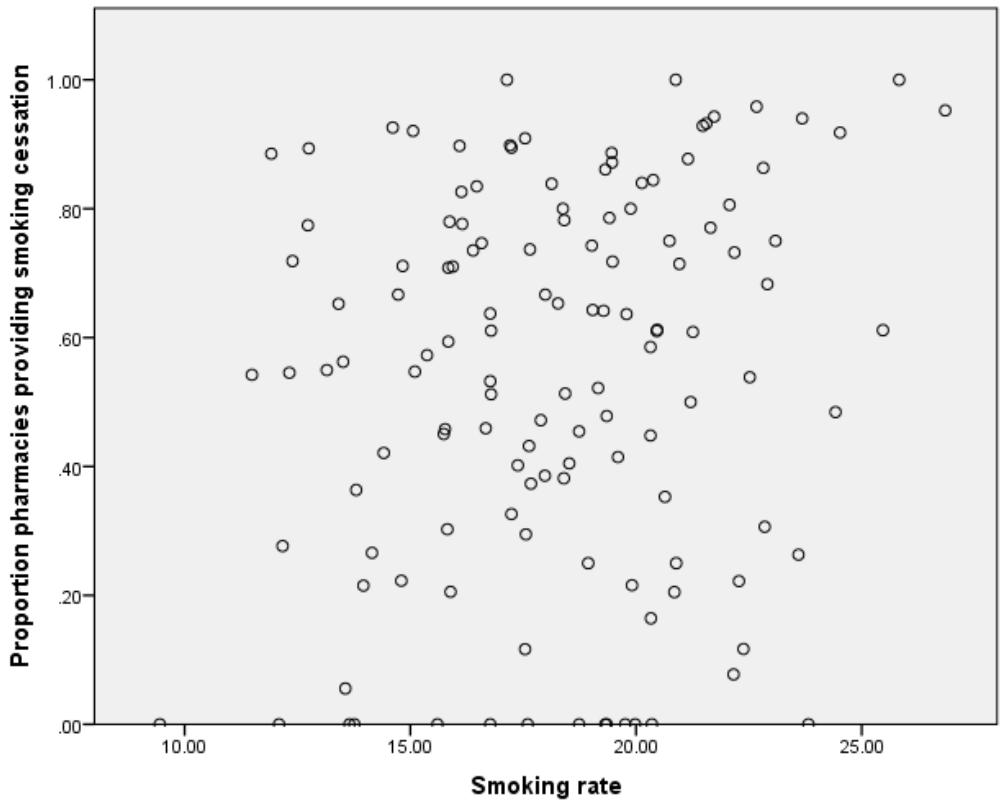
