- 4. Feasibility The research topic is viable and doable for a scientific research project and no problems are to be expected with regard to its implementation.
- 5. Novelty of the concept The research topic represents a new or emerging area.
- 6. Lack of (good quality) evidence Synthesized evidence for the research topic is either not existing, lacking in quality, not up to date, or only applicable to a different context.
