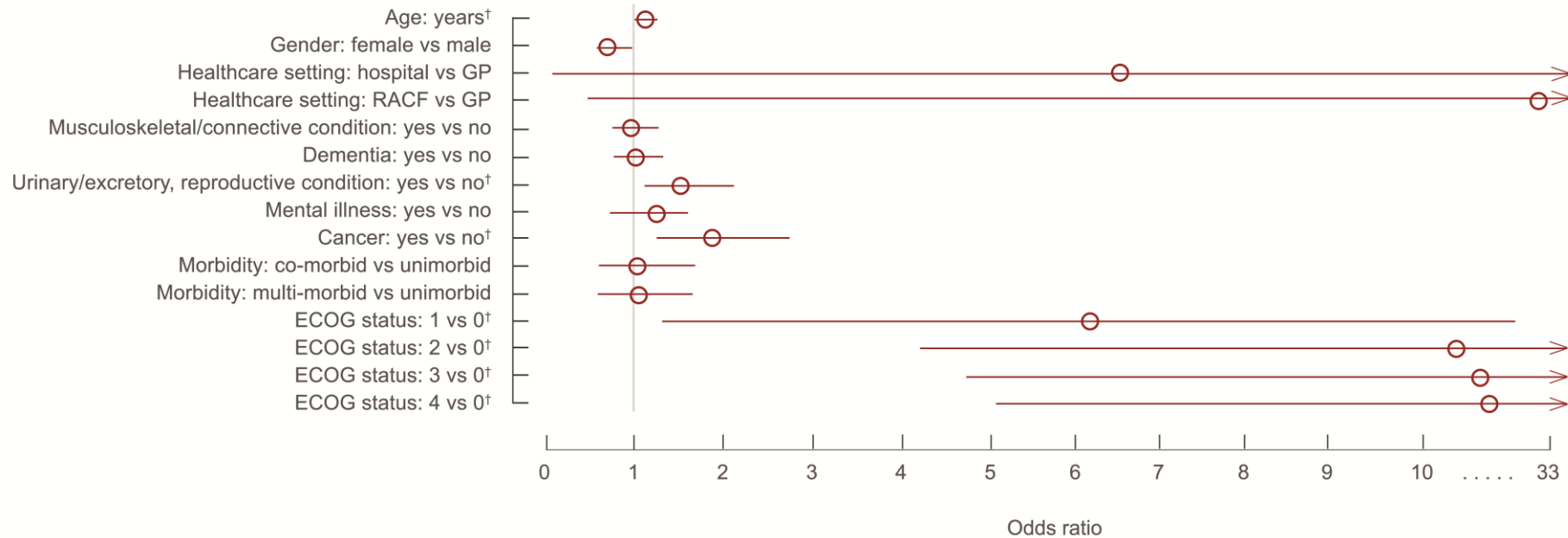


Figure 1. Odds ratios for factors associated with having at least one advance care directive after the data were weighted for age, gender and jurisdiction ($n = 1,601$).
