1. What are the most frequent and important decisions you (and your caregiver) face as you live and age at home? Why are these decisions important?
2. Who else besides yourself is typically involved when you make important decisions?
3. What do you (and your caregivers) do when faced with making important decisions (e.g., how do you go about making decisions)?
4. How do you (and your caregiver) typically feel when you need to make an important decision?
5. Do you consult with health care providers in making important health decisions (e.g., nurses, physicians, pharmacist, others)? If so, what is his/her usual role?
6. What factors make the decision more difficult for you (and your caregiver) to make?
7. Do you use the Internet to help you make important decisions? If so, how?
8. What would help you (and your caregivers) to make better decisions?
9. What would help you (and your caregiver) overcome some of the things that get in the way of your decision making?
10. What factors would make it easier for you (and your caregiver) to make important decisions?
