The JBI 3-Step Search Strategy:

Step 1: An initial limited search of at least two appropriate online databases: PubMed and AgeLine

e.g., Search in PubMed

S4	S1 AND S2 AND S3	5 657

This search was followed by an analysis of text words in the title and abstract of relevant articles and identified keywords and index terms used to describe the articles. Search terms were identified for step 2.

Step 2: The identified keywords and index terms used to describe the articles will be used to conduct a second search in all selected databases: PubMed, EMBASE, CINAHL, AgeLine, PsycInfo, and Scopus.

Here is the complete list of search terms: (Older adult* OR senior* OR older person*) AND (virtual* OR tele* OR video*) AND (team* OR care partner) AND (assess* OR evaluat* OR care OR goal*). Grey literature will be retrieved through Google and Google Scholar using the same search terms as above.

Step 3: The reference lists of all articles and reports selected to be included in the review will be hand searched for additional studies. Unless the outcomes are determined to be different after screening, only the most recent report on a study will be included in the review. Published reports, unpublished reports, and related articles will be searched on Google Scholar.
